Individual Courses within Full-Time Career Majors: Student must pay for a minimum of 60 hours plus required supplies, materials and fees.

LPN, Cosmetology, and Auto Service Master Technician Tuition: Will be divided into three equal payments. Tuition for all other career majors will be divided into two equal payments.

Dental Hygiene Tuition: As set by the University of Oklahoma College of Dentistry (within the SOTC/OUCOD agreements including tuition, fees, and local fees).

Fees and Supplies

Fees are due on or before the first day of class.

Payment Options

- a. Cash, check, or credit card

Note: Failure of the student or student’s sponsor to make payment on time will result in an immediate administrative withdrawal.

SOTC Waivers

SOTC waivers and scholarships will be available to in-district patrons for up to one half of tuition balance due after other financial aid has been exhausted.

Applicants must:

- Complete FAFSA (for Career Majors 600 hours or more)
- Meet Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) according to SOTC Policy

Scholarships and Awards

Scholarships and awards received on behalf of the student by SOTC will be applied or disbursed in the following order:

1. Outstanding tuition or fees due SOTC,
2. Purchases paid out-of-pocket by the student for testing, certifications, books, uniforms or other expenses directly related to their field of study at SOTC,
3. SOTC Waivers for tuition.

Any remaining monies will be distributed to the student. Itemized receipts must be provided when requesting reimbursement for out-of-pocket expenses.
