

Pre-Pharmacy Technician Program

98% of students who successfully complete this program pass the Pharmacy Technician Certification Board Exam compared to 80% pass rate quoted by PTCB's website.

Length of Program

Our 300 clock hour program consists of an online course that includes many online lessons, reinforcement activities, and tests of the course content. Students have up to 16 weeks to complete the program. If the program is not completed in 16 weeks, students may purchase an additional 2 weeks of access to the class for \$99.

Instructional Methods

Our independent study program utilizes an internet based student learning management system to present courses in the form of modular plans of study that involve computer assisted learning software, videos, and online activities. The course is self-paced.

Attendance

Our program offers students a flexible attendance environment. Students must clock in a minimum of 10 hours per week. The hours will be considered independent study. Students must inform the Corporate and Career Development Department (CCD) of their planned schedules 3 weeks in advance. Students are asked to call if they cannot make a day scheduled. Students are sometimes allowed to work in hours outside of their planned schedule, but must call 580.224.8201 to request room use.

Progression

Weekly minimum attendance requirements of 10 hours. Please be advised, the 300 hour program cannot be completed only attending the minimum 10 hours during the 16 week program.

Orientation

A conference with a Training Developer will be scheduled after students have enrolled, paid tuition, and received an ID and Login for the program, and the student has turned in a minimum of 3 weeks planned room schedule (must be reviewed and approved prior to attendance) but before the student begins their first course. The conference will include the following:

Program Attendance

Students who do not adhere to SOUTHERN TECH CCD program attendance policies may not finish the program, and not receive a refund. Examples are not attending campus a minimum of 10 hours per week, etc. Each student's program attendance will be evaluated and documented every weeks. Step one on the probationary scale is considered grace with no penalty. Step two, the student will be placed on warning and will have a meeting with coordinator to discuss the situation. Step three; the student will be placed on probation for the duration of the program. Step four; the student will be dismissed. Specific rules and regulations pertaining to the probationary scale are discussed in further detail throughout the guidelines.
